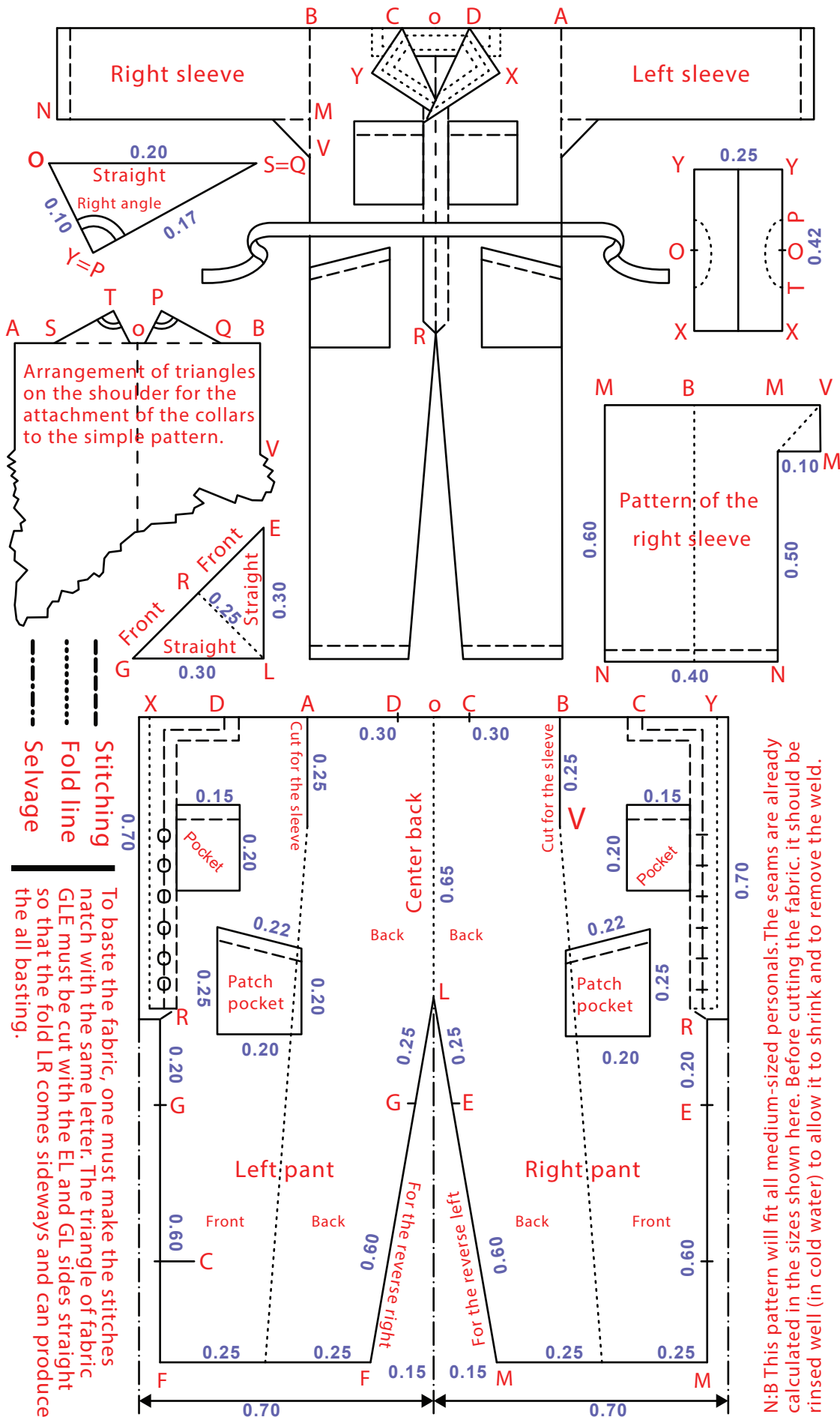


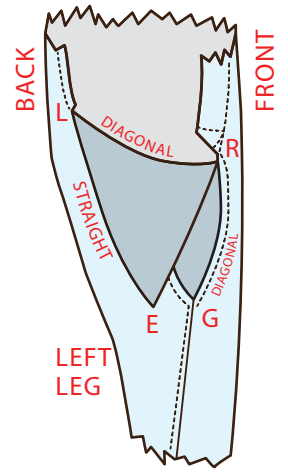
# HOW TO CUT OUT THE "TUTA" STRAIGHT LINE GARMENT BY THYAHT



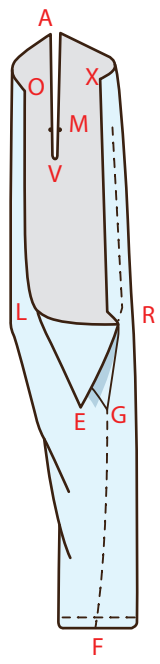
Arrangement of triangles on the shoulder for the attachment of the collars to the simple pattern.

To baste the fabric, one must make the stitches natch with the same letter. The triangle of fabric GLE must be cut with the EL and GL sides straight so that the fold LR comes sideways and can produce the all basting.

Sectional view of left side of "Tuta" showing the position of the GLE folded over angle RL. AV is the slit when the sleeve is sew in.



Showing how the triangle GLE gets pulled into curved lines as soon as the Tuta is worn. The triangle allows complete freedom of movement and never pulls.



N:B This pattern will fit all medium-sized personals. The seams are already calculated in the sizes shown here. Before cutting the fabric, it should be rinsed well (in cold water) to allow it to shrink and to remove the weld.
